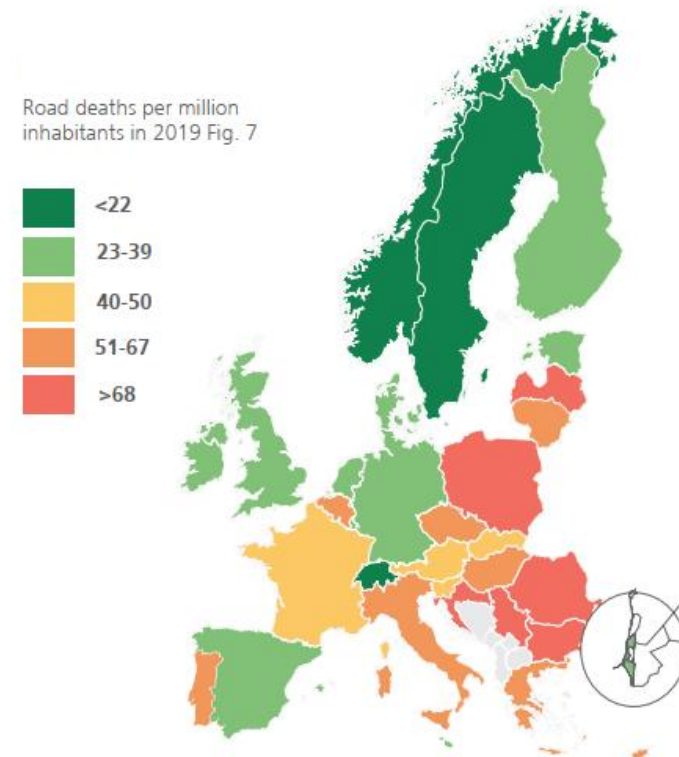

Ranking road safety performance across participating countries since 2006.



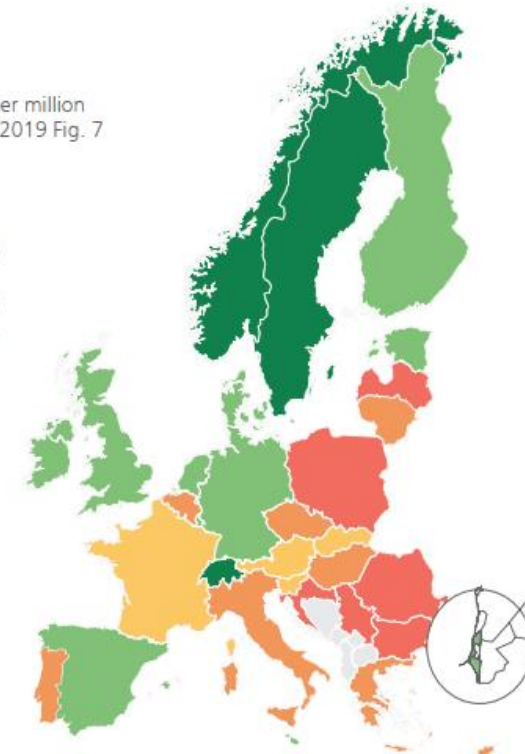
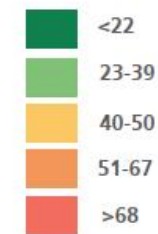

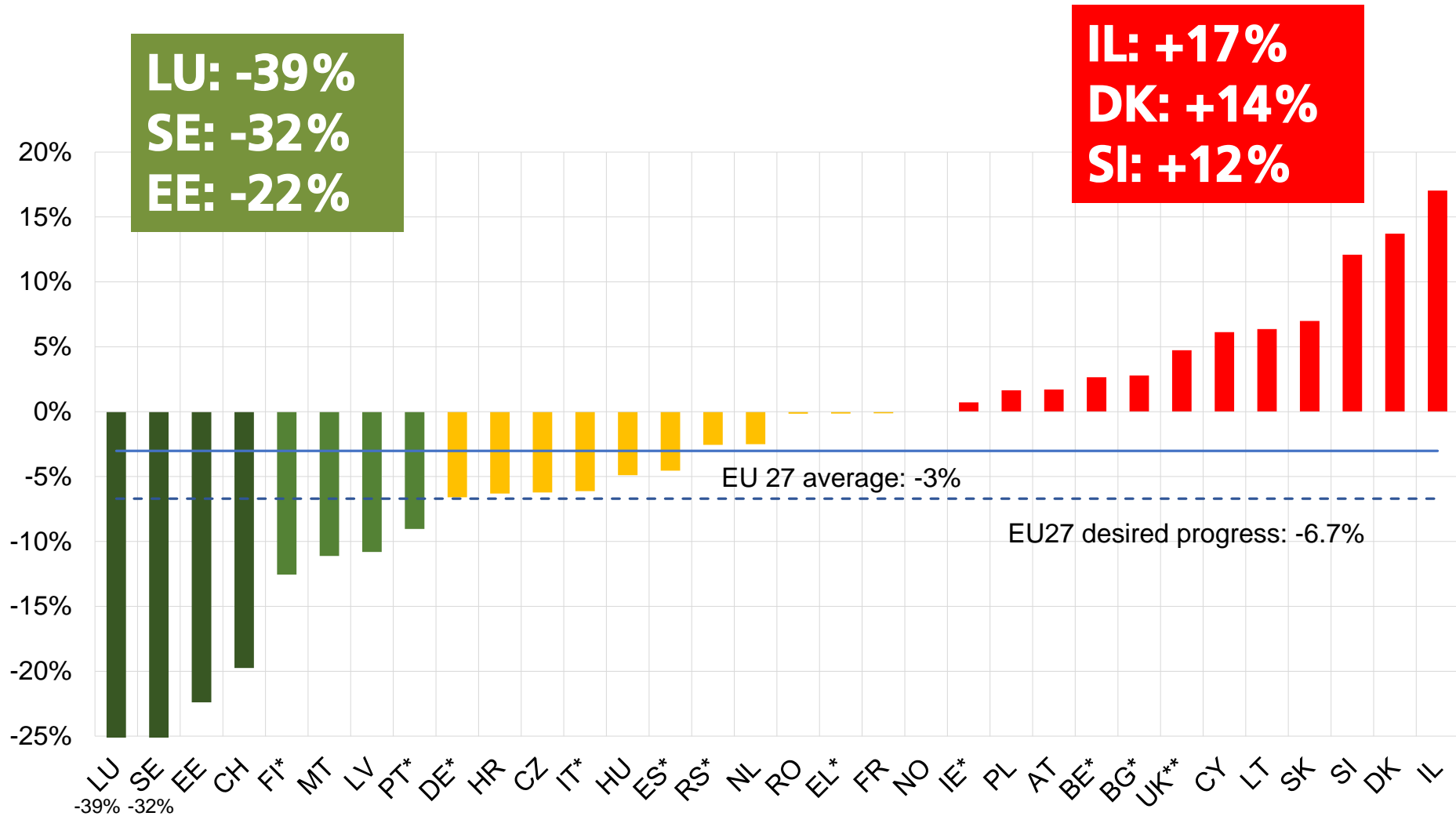
Road deaths per million inhabitants in 2019 Fig. 7



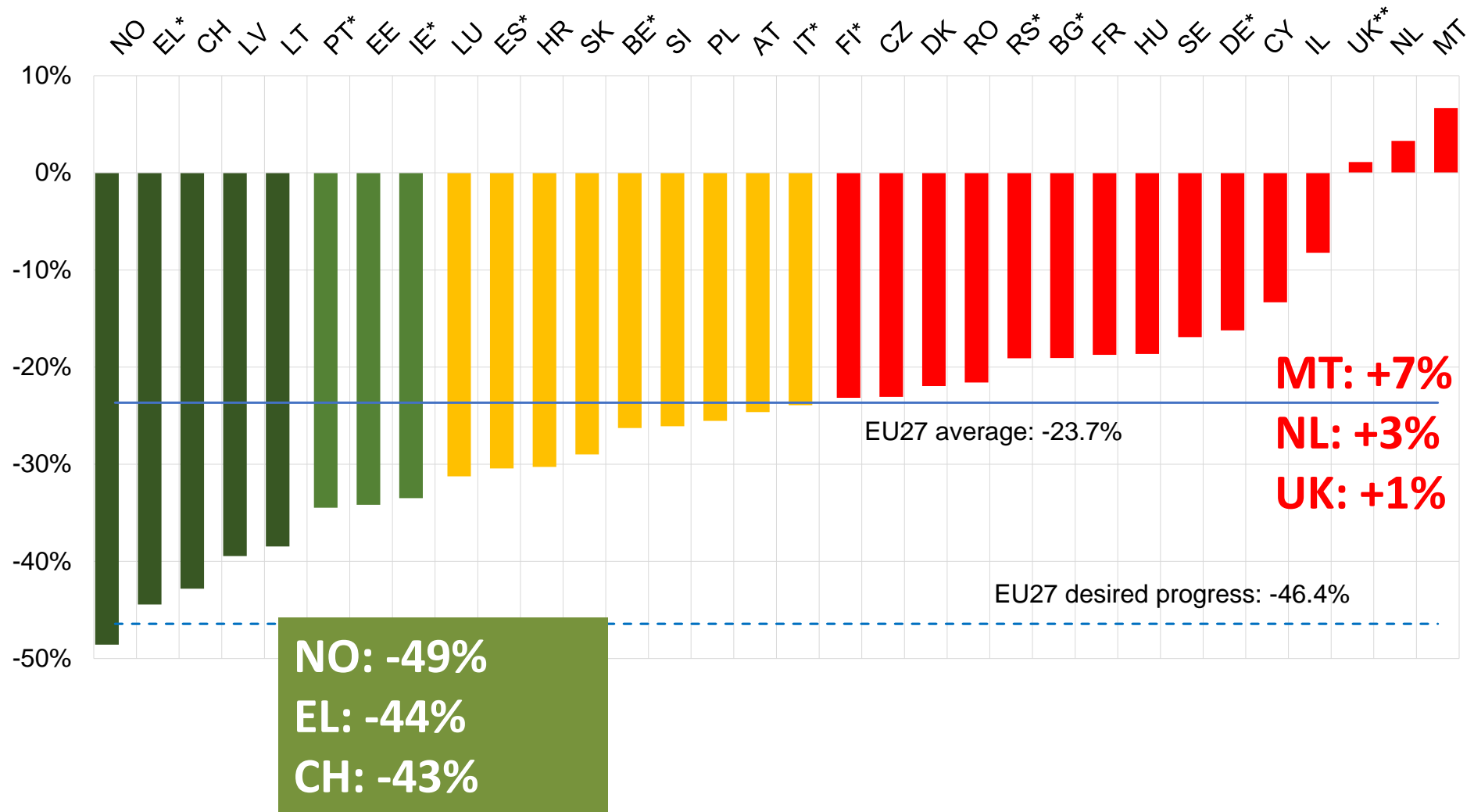

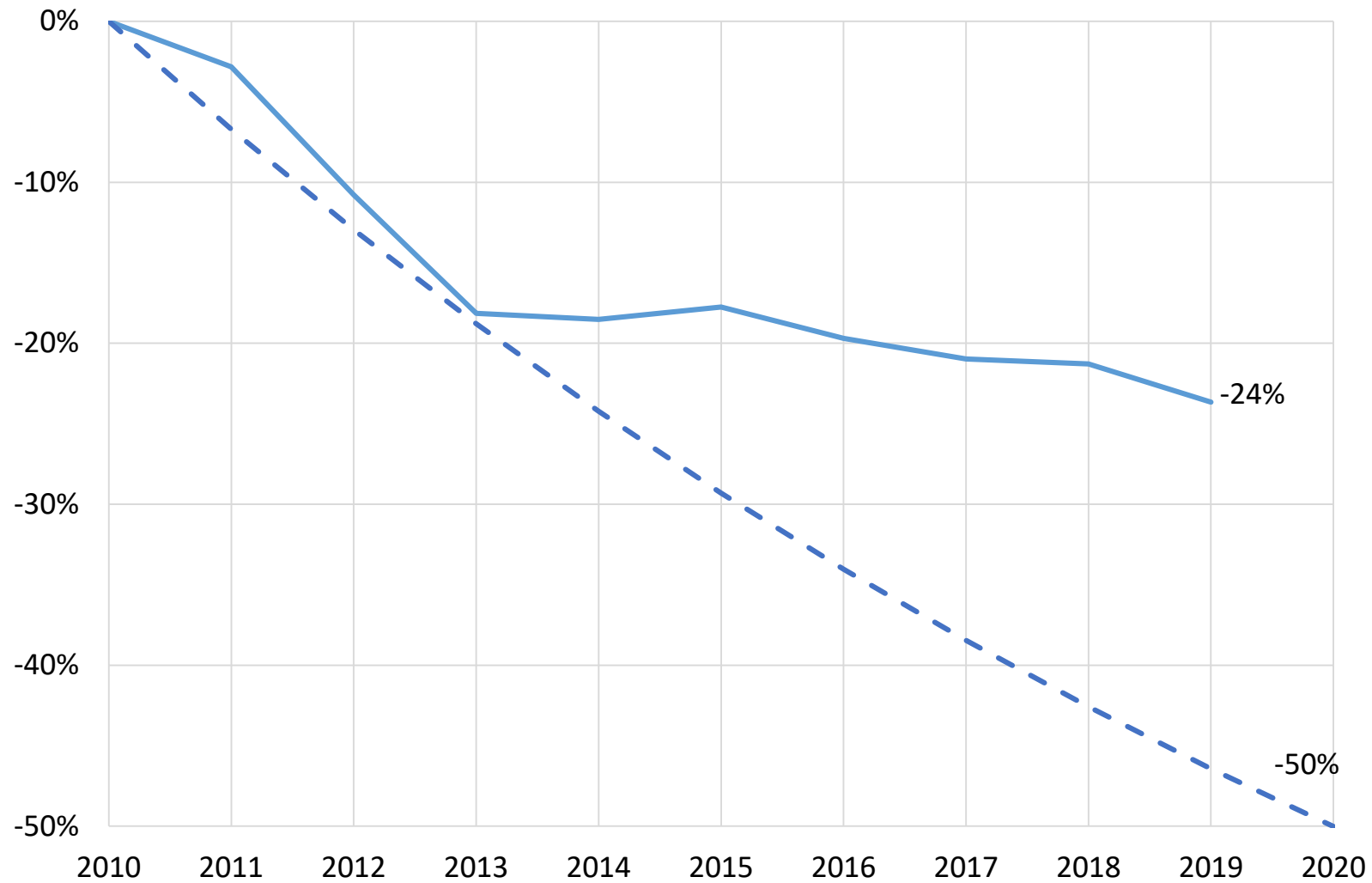
PROGRESS 2018 - 2019



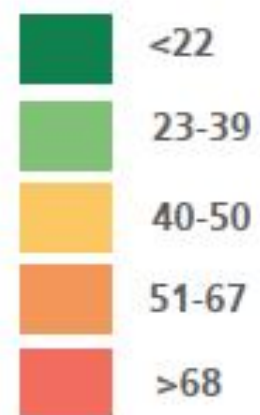
PROGRESS 2010 - 2019
