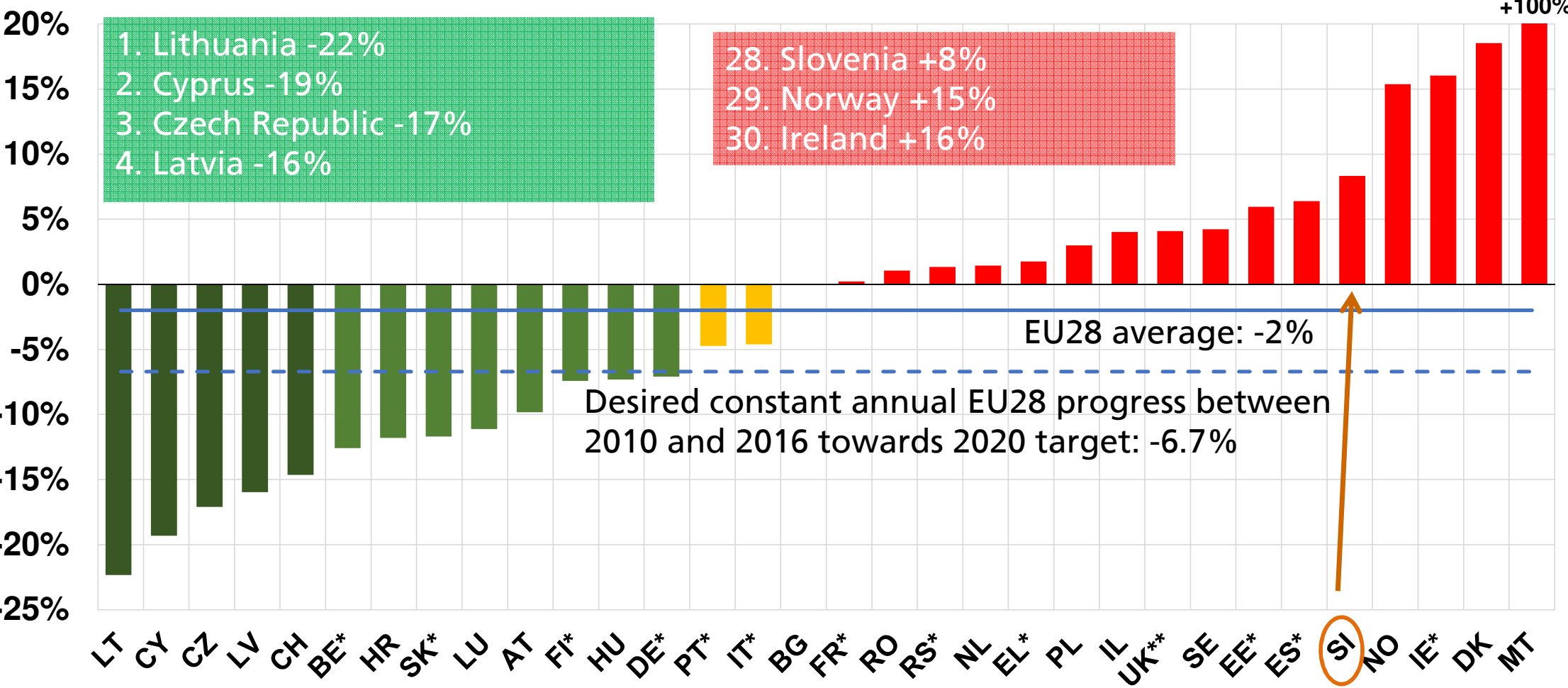
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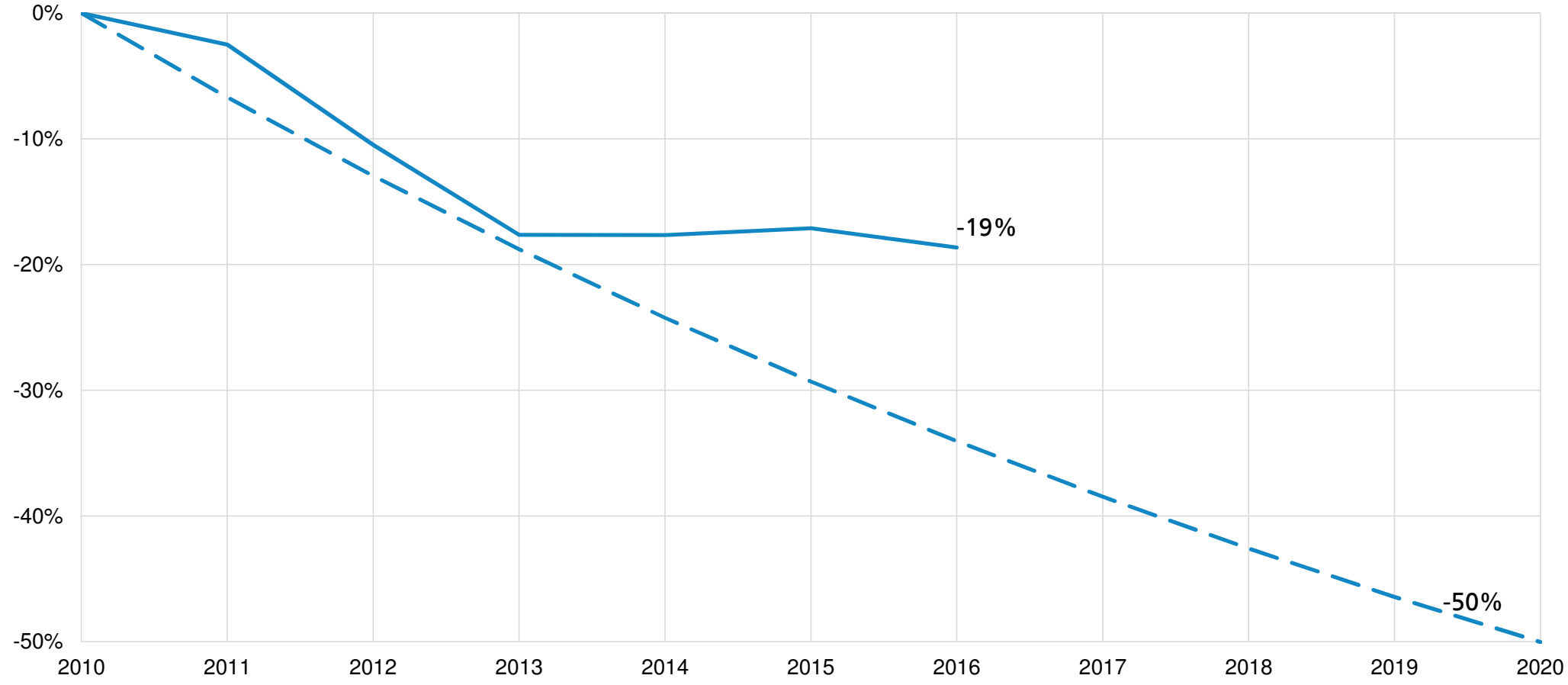
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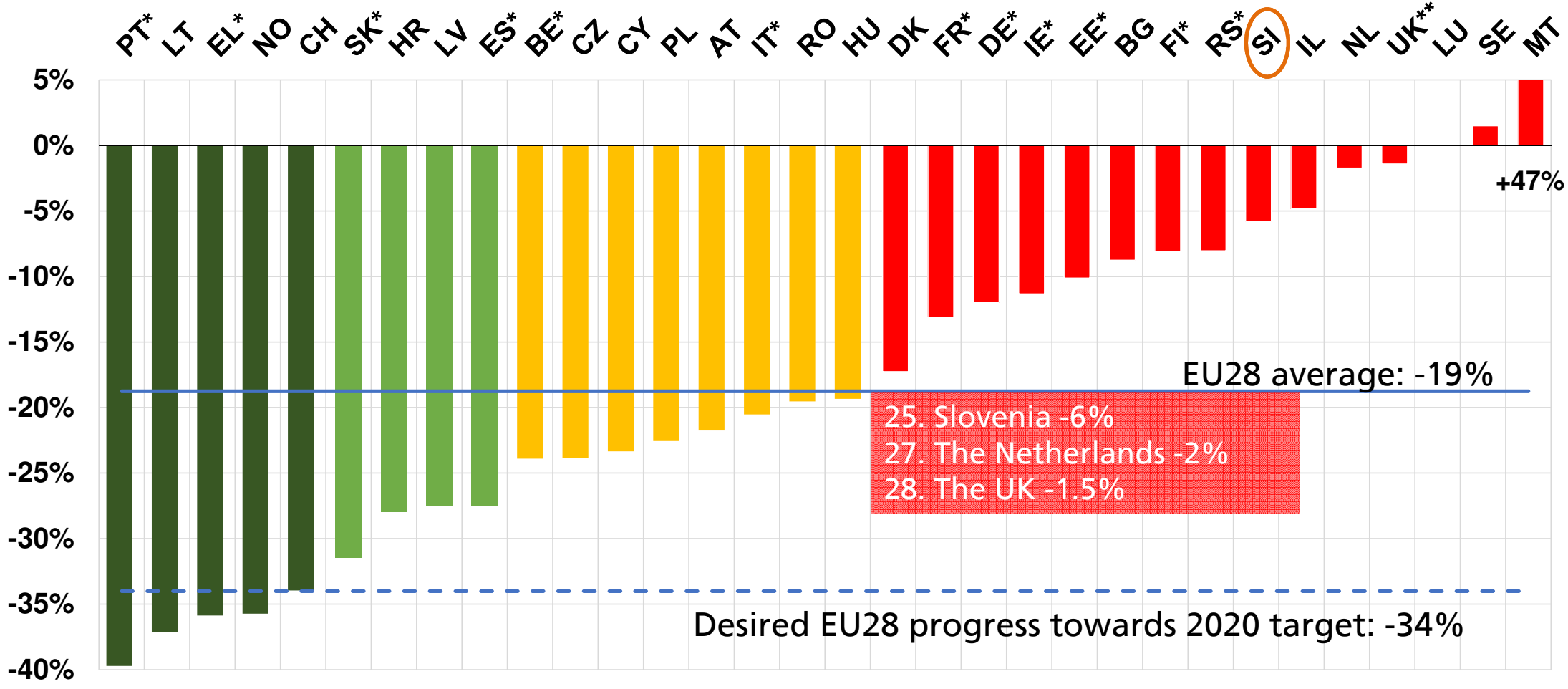
RELATIVE CHANGE (%) IN ROAD DEATHS 2015-2016



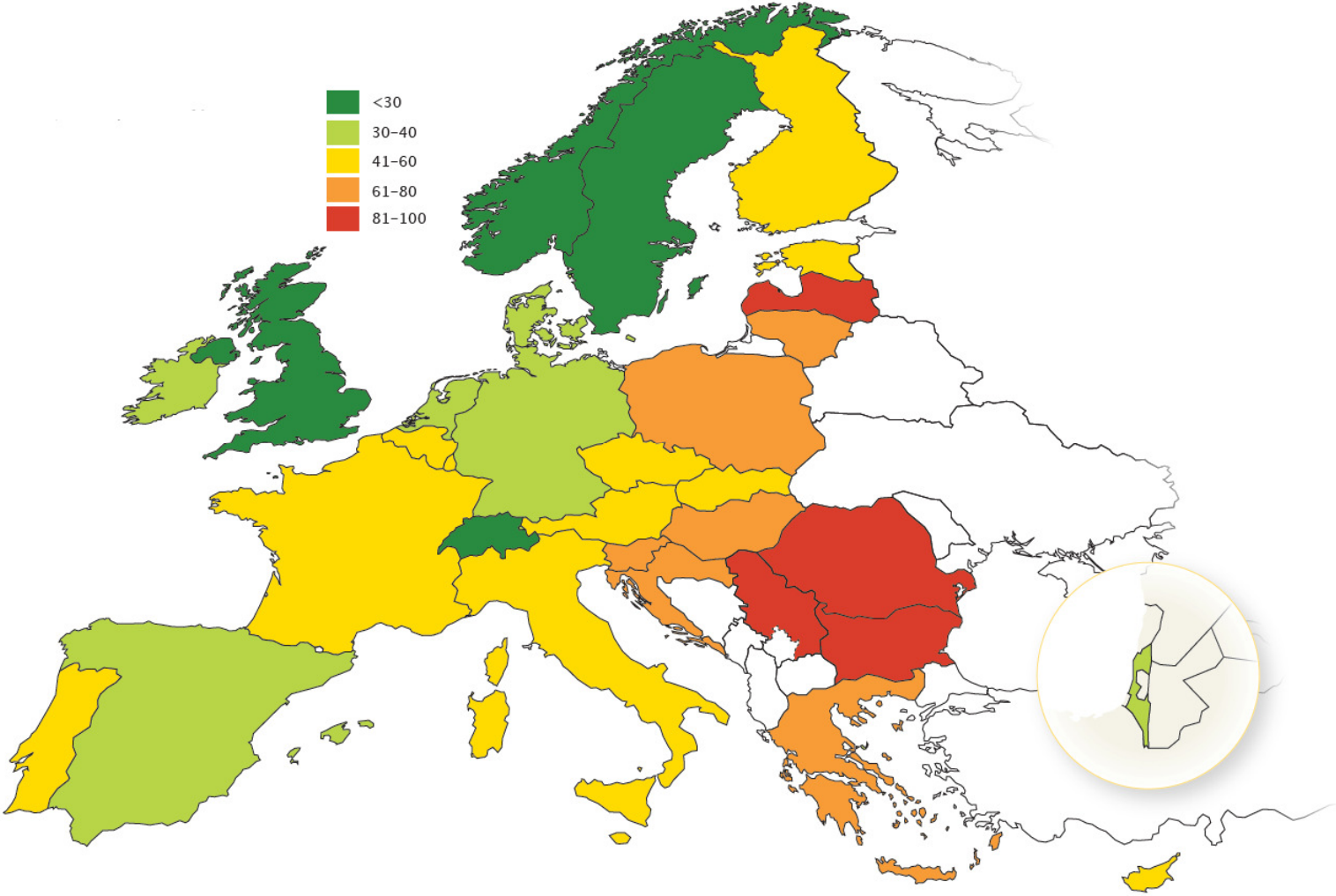
WIDENING GAP BETWEEN THE ACTUAL AND DESIRED PROGRESS TOWARDS 2020 TARGET

FOR A EUROPEAN TARGET TO REDUCE SERIOUS ROAD INJURIES



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OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACTION

- Continue to collect serious injuries according to the MAIS 3+ definition, coupled with an introduction and implementation of serious road injury reduction strategy
- Continue to commit to work with health authorities to offer high standards of rescue, hospital care and long-term rehabilitation, following a road collision
- Increase enforcement of the main risk factors
- Encourage local authorities to adopt zones with a speed limit of 30km/h in residential areas and areas used by many pedestrians and cyclists
