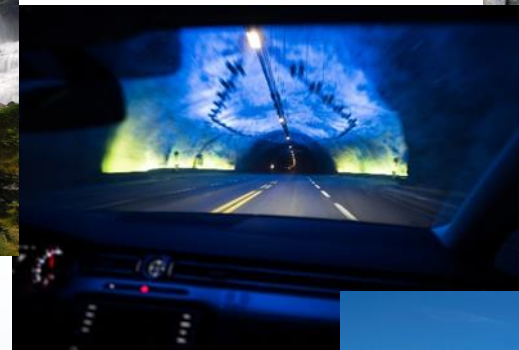


Norway

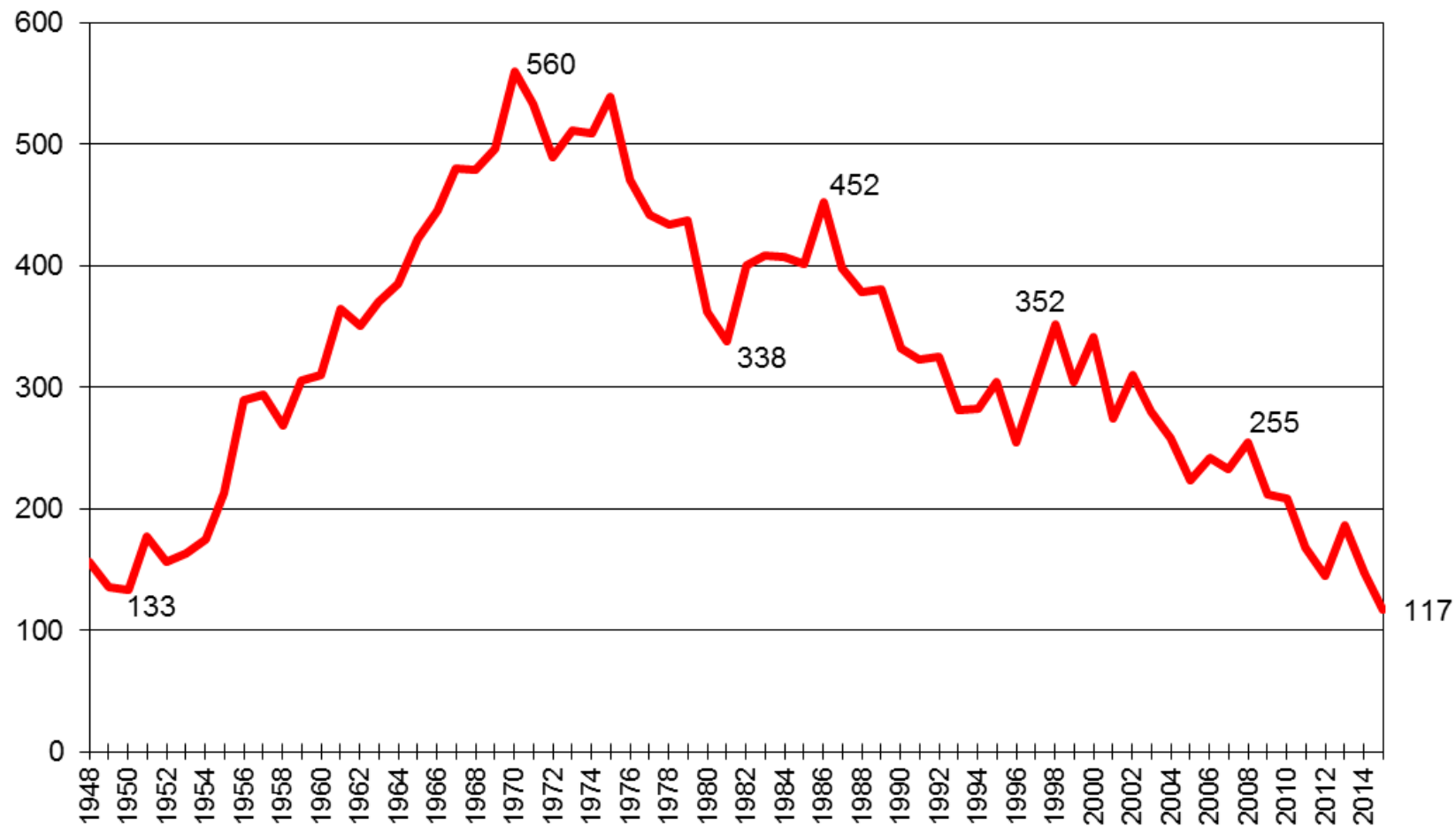
- 5, 2 million inhabitants

- 91 000 km public roads
- 120 000 km private roads (mountain, forest)
- 540 km motorways
- 1 100 road tunnels
- 600 harbours
- 51 airports
- 4 200 km railway
- GDP app. 300 billion EUR (57 700 EUR per capita)



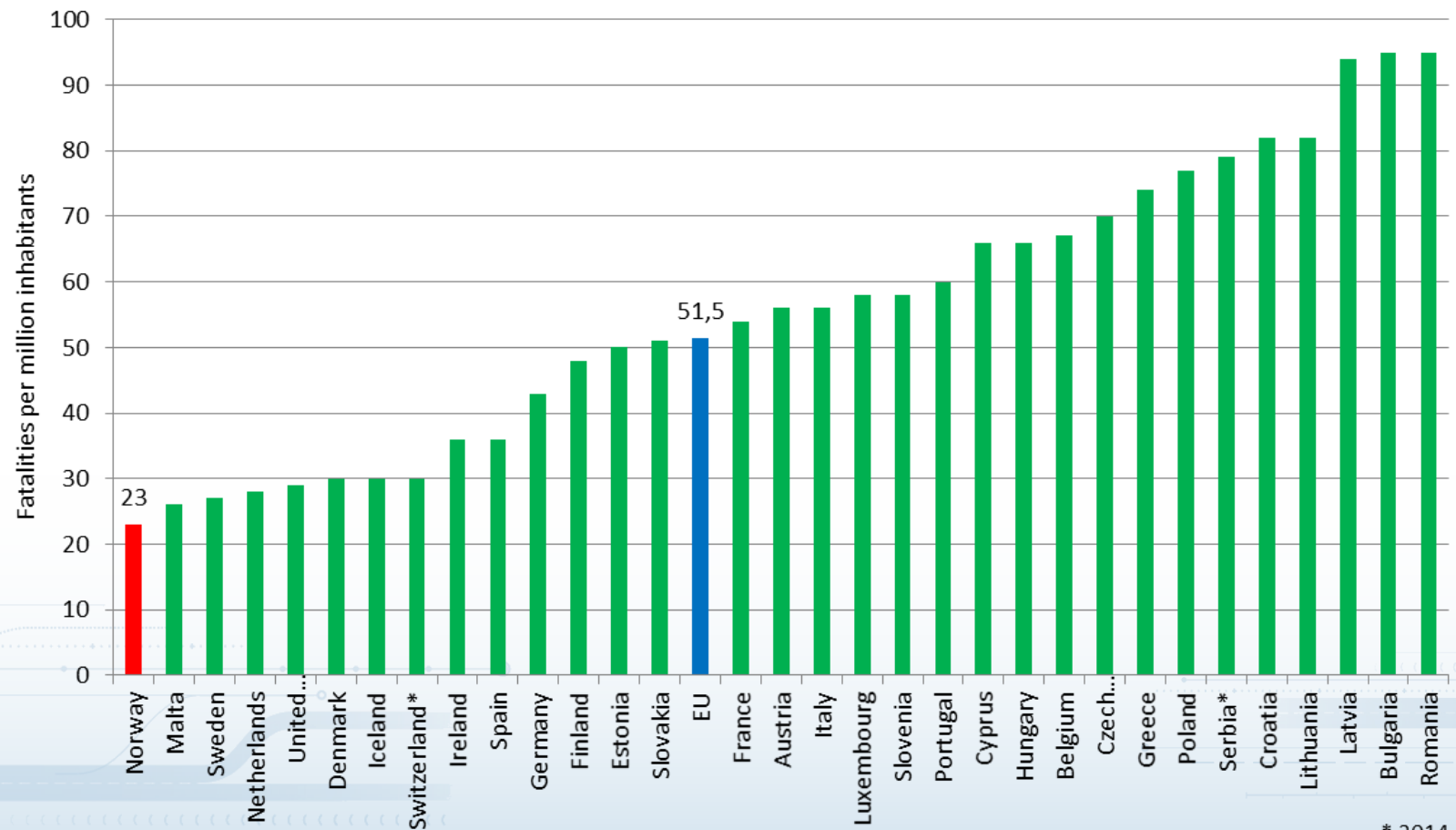

- Broad spectrum of measures

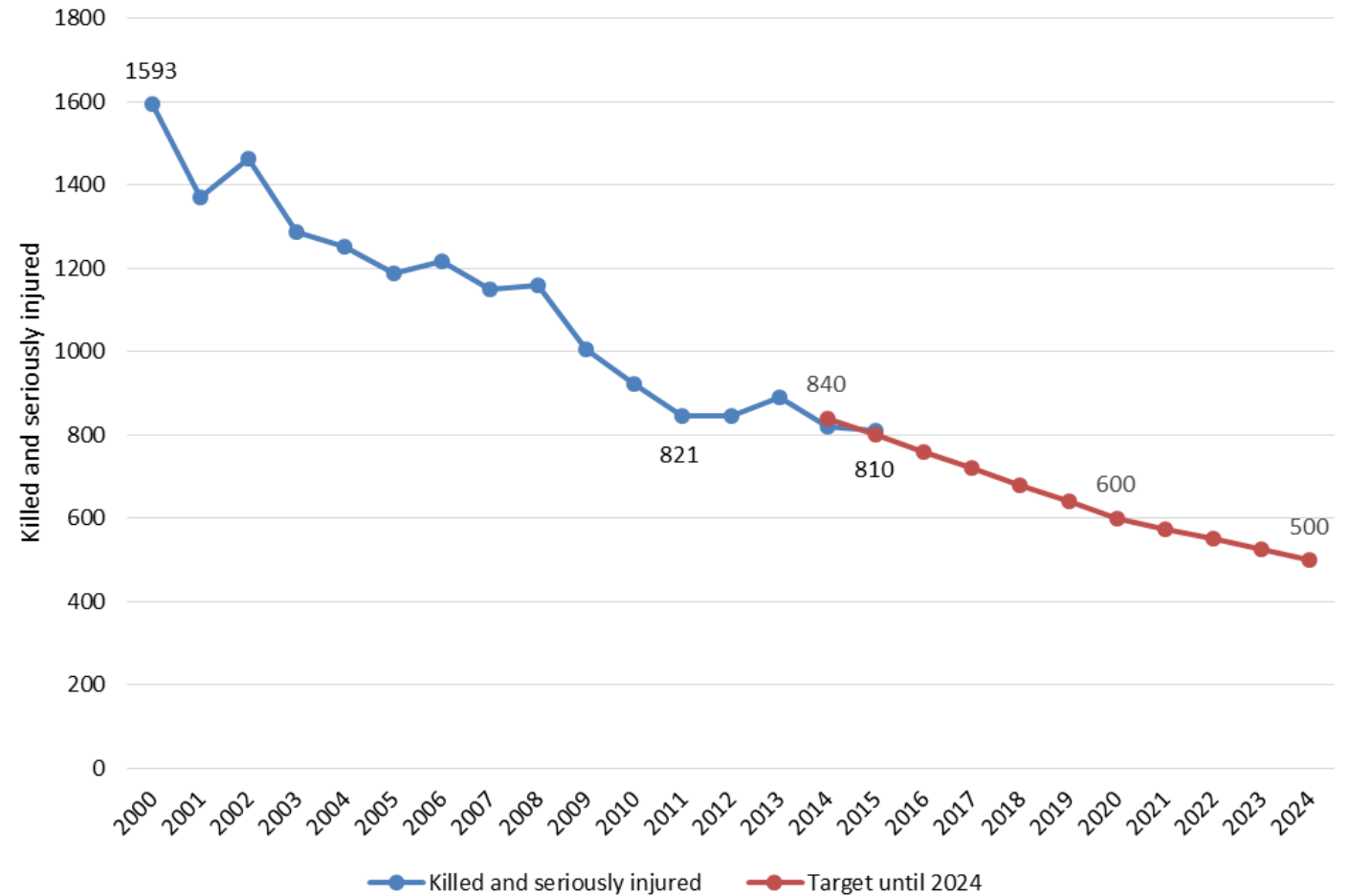


Vision Zero – A Safe System

National Plan of Action for Road Traffic Safety 2014-2017

Challenges in the years to come

- Increased number of pedestrians and bicyclists in cities and urban areas
- Increased population of older road users
- Increased proportions of heavy goods vehicles
- Already a high level of road safety
